Article 1 – Legal Provisions

Article 2 – Access to the Website

Access to the website and the use of it is strictly personal. You will not use this website nor the data and information provided thereon for commercial, political or advertising purposes, nor for any commercial offers and especially not for unsolicited electronic offers.

Article 3 – The Contents of the Website

Article 4 – The Administration of the Website

Article 6 – The Collection of Data

Your data will be collected by 4 Light Technical Projects B.V. Personal data are understood to mean: all information on an identified or identifiable natural person; identifiable is understood to mean a natural person who can be directly or indirectly identified, particularly by an identifier such as a name, an identification number, location data, an online identifier, or one or more elements particular to the physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural or social identity.

The personal data collected on the website are mainly used by the administrator in order to maintain relations with you and if applicable process your orders.

Article 7 – Your Rights Regarding Your Details

Under Article 13 paragraph 2 sub b GDPR anyone has the right to information on and access to, rectification, and erasure of his personal data or restriction of the processing of his personal data, as well as the right to object to the processing and the right to data portability. Any request thereto must be accompanied by a copy of a valid identity document, on which you have placed your signature and stating the address at which you can be contacted. Within 1 month after submission of the request, you will receive a reply. Depending on the complexity and number of requests, this period can if necessary be extended by 2 months.

Article 8 – Processing of Personal Data

In the case of a breach of any laws and/or regulations, of which the visitor is a suspect and for which the authorities require personal data the administrator has collected, these will be provided to them after an explicit and substantiated request by those authorities, after which these personal data will consequently fall under the protection of the terms of this privacy policy.

Should certain information be necessary in order to gain access to certain functionalities of the website, the party responsible will specify the mandatory nature of this information at the time the data is requested.
